# Its good for you now...

- Students enrolled in arts courses score higher in reading and math on standardized tests.
- The more arts courses you take, the higher your test scores go.

## The Arts Are Core

The arts are recognized as a core academic subject under the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act, and

**48 states** have adopted standards for learning in the arts.



## The Arts Are Motivating

The arts help our students to:

### Succeed in School

Students who are involved in the arts are:

**4** times more likely to participate in a math and science fair

**3** times more likely to win an award for **school attendance**

**4** times more likely to be recognized for **academic achievement**

**3** times more likely to be elected to **class office**

### Stay in School

Low socioeconomic status (SES) students with a **high** participation in the arts have a dropout rate of 4 percent, but their peers with a **low** participation in the arts have a dropout rate of 22 percent.

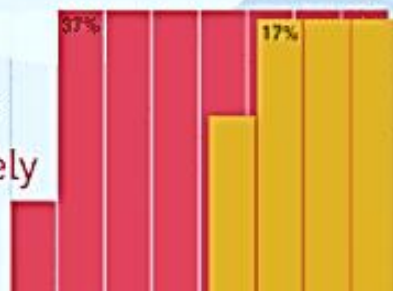
### Succeed in Work

**72%** of business leaders say that **creativity** is the number one skill they are seeking when hiring.

### Succeed in Life

Low-income students who are highly engaged in the arts are **more than twice as likely** to **graduate college** as their peers with no arts education.

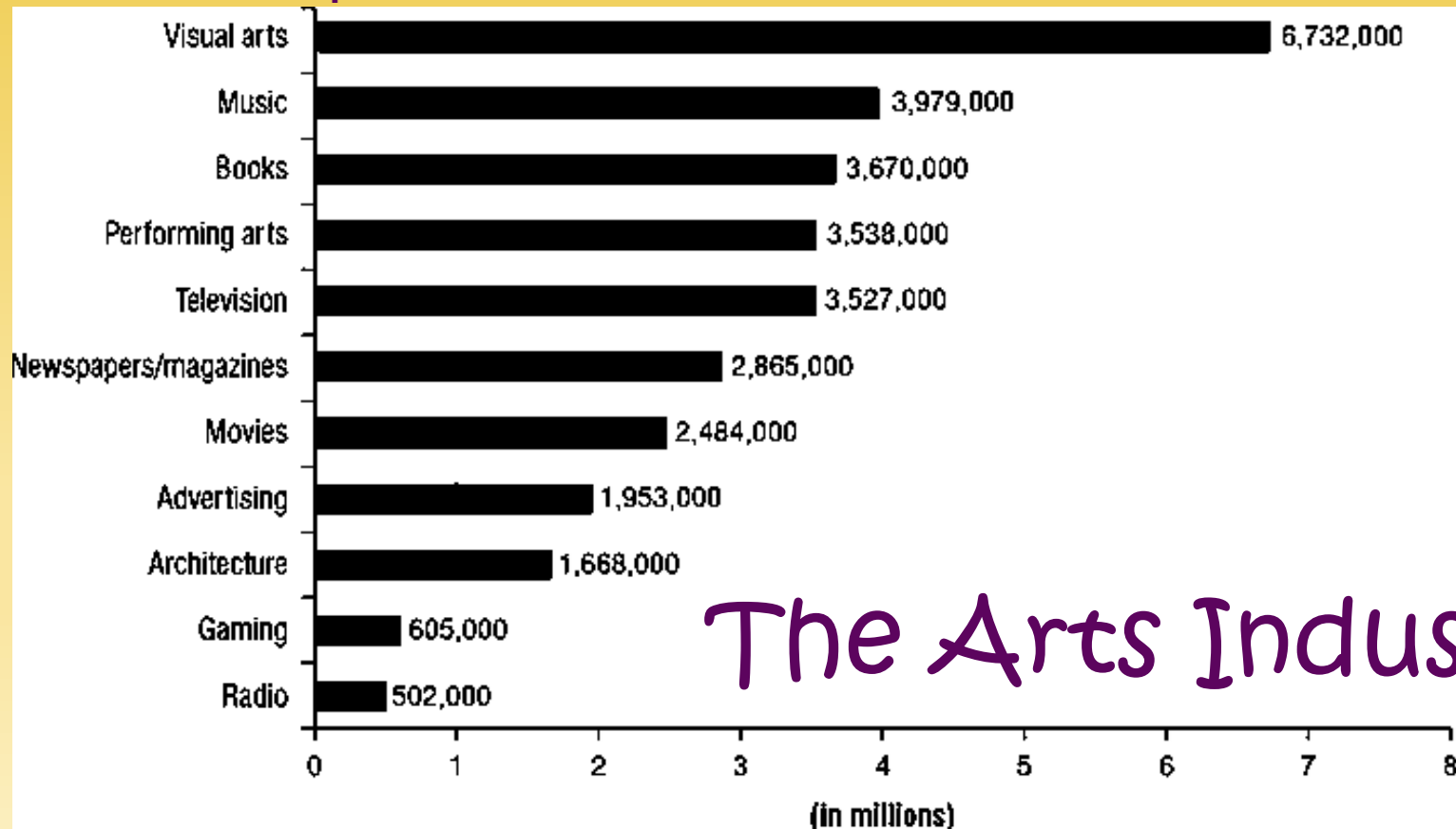


# What Can the arts do for you?

2. Art builds a keener sense of perception, contributing to making better decisions.
3. Art engages the senses.
4. Art helps you relax.
5. Art stimulates creativity.
6. Art helps develop individuality and independence.
7. Art helps to build self-esteem.
8. Art gives you a sense of well-being.
9. Art generates enjoyment. Its social!
10. Art promotes self-expression.
11. Art promotes abstract thinking.
12. Art gives you a feeling of accomplishment.
13. Art promotes non-verbal communication skills.
14. Art is exhilarating.
15. Art teaches us more about ourselves than we imagined.

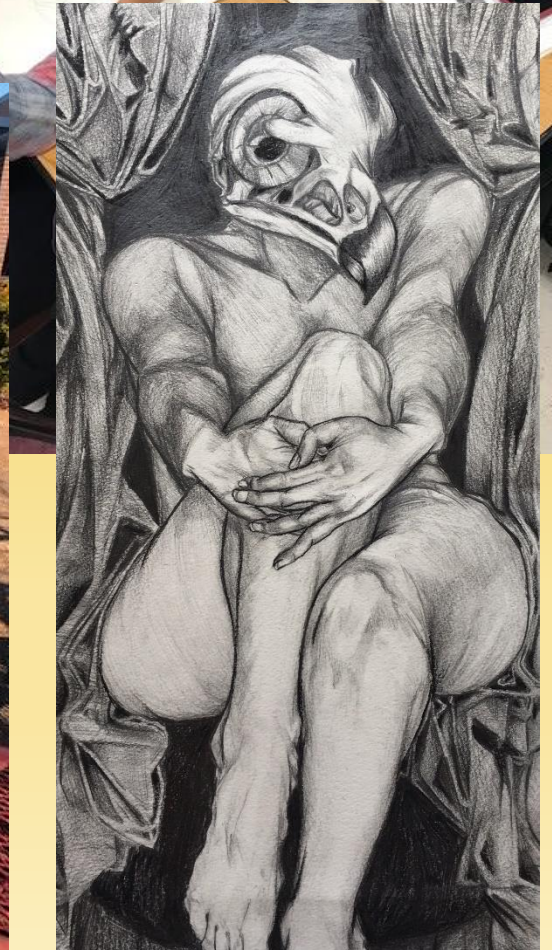
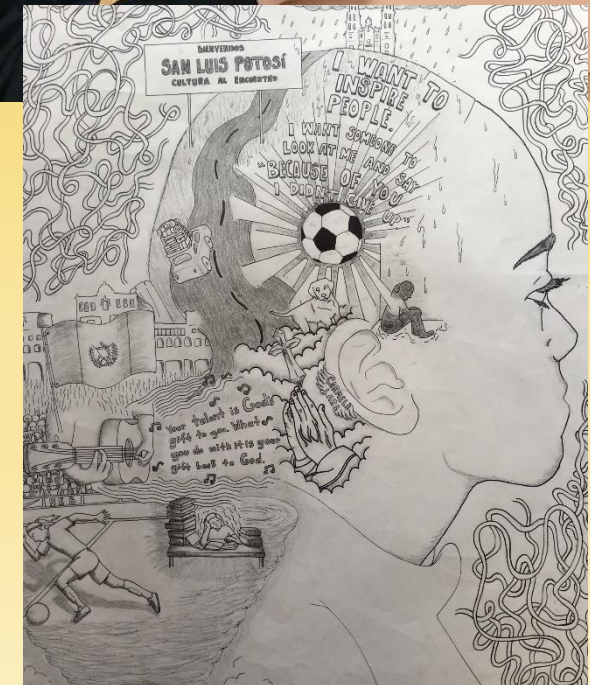
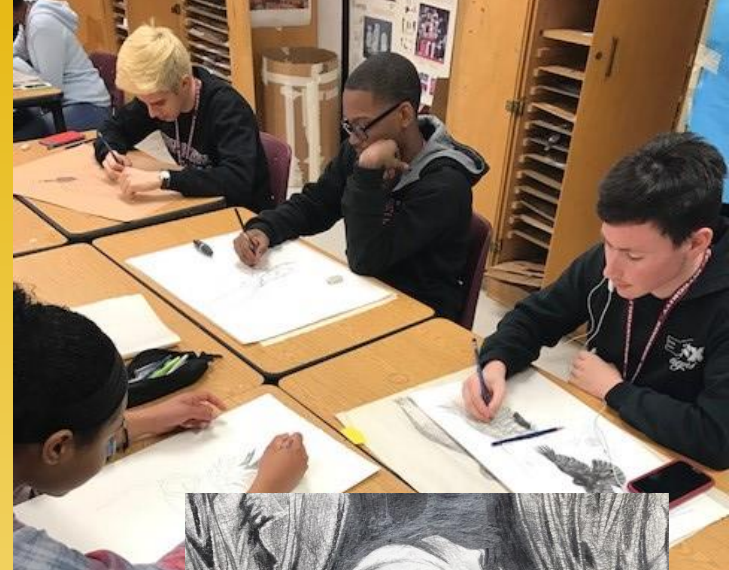
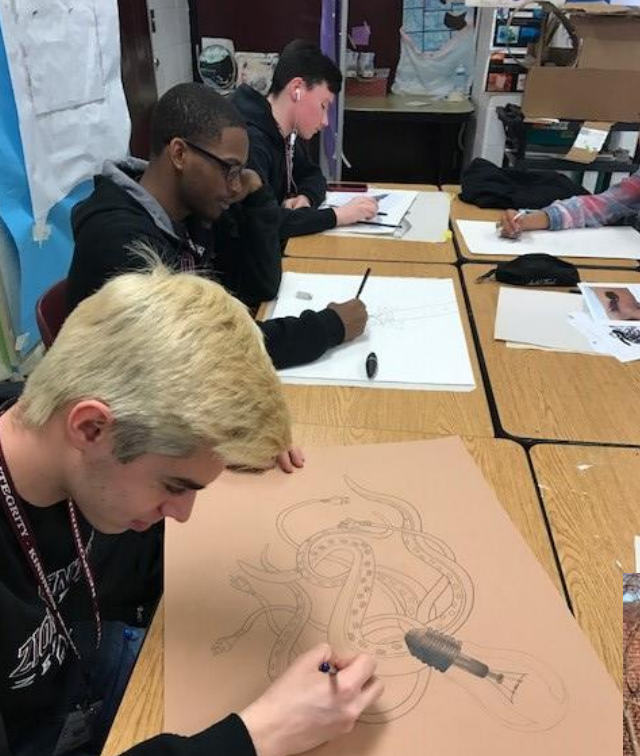


# Drawing

# Graphic Art Design

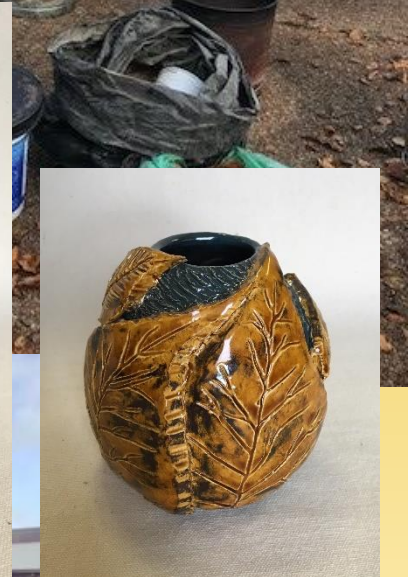
- Learn Illustrator and Photoshop

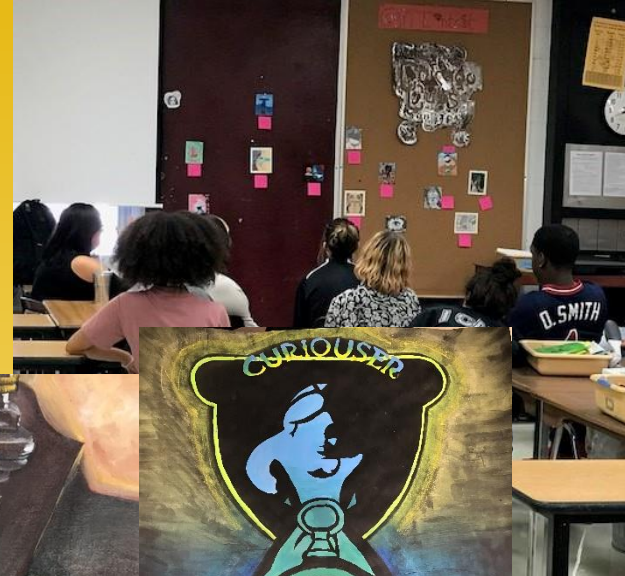






# Painting

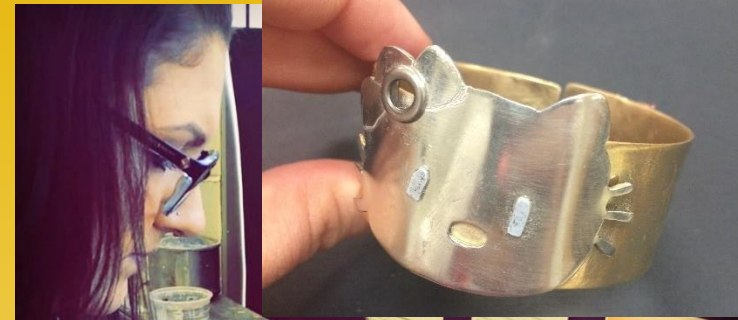

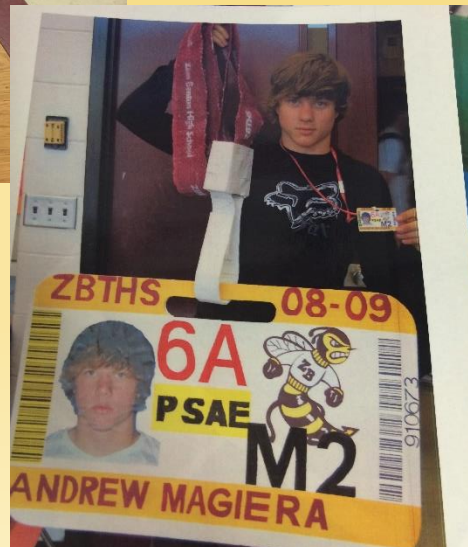




# 3-D Art Sculpture



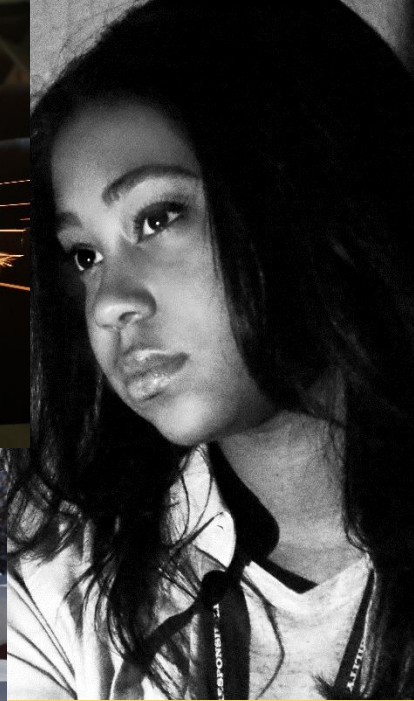

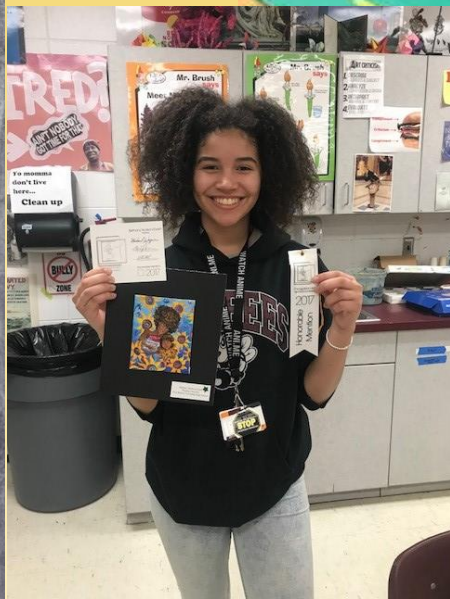


# Intro to AP + AP Art
